Safety Briefing Sheet

Risks of entering or being on or in the water –

Under no circumstances are any passengers allowed to jump into the water from a moving vessel. Furthermore, no passenger is allowed to enter the water until the Captain/Skipper has given the 'all clear' to do so. Please note that swimming is permitted once the vessel has stopped its engines and the skipper has given the "all clear" to enter the water. As the "hirer" of the vessel, it is your responsibility to ensure that your guests are advised of any dangers above or below the water including mixing water activities after consuming alcohol and/or Sharks, Sea Lions and other wildlife.

Guests that chose to dive or swim in the water do so at his or her own risk. Big Island Charters cannot be held liable or responsible for any damages or injuries that may occur to any passenger from activities involving (but not limited to) swimming or diving into the water, or interactions with wildlife etc. Sea Lions, dolphins or any other animals/sea creatures.

The Captain and Master of our vessel should provide an in-depth safety briefing before departure. If you have any questions, please ask the Captain prior to your departure.
